CCA's noteworthy accomplishments in Oregon

- The leading organization that is driving the ban of destructive gillnetting on the mainstem lower Columbia River.
- Established selective recreational angling as the management priority for the lower Columbia River.
- Addressing and educating the public on predation issues that include Sea Lions and Cormorants.
- Protected the nearshore ocean fisheries from sweeping arbitrary closures.
- Advocating and maintaining hatchery fish for harvest.
- Supporting local marine law enforcement via the poaching tip hotline.
- Initiated scientific studies e.g. hatchery impacts on wild stocks.

The objective of CCA is to conserve, promote and enhance the present and future availability of these marine resources for the benefit and enjoyment of the public. CCA Oregon is comprised of local chapters spanning all regions of the state.
